

# The `ghab` package

Provides `\darghab` command for typesetting ghab boxes which has the following syntax:

```
\darghab [<width>] {<text>}
```

The optional *<width>* determines the width of the box and if you do not give this optional argument, then the width of the box will be equal to `\linewidth`
